HOURS OF OPERATION

RYDEs operate from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday

SCHEDULING RIDES

Call 36 hours prior to requested ride or book a ride up to 5 weeks in advance.

PASSENGER ACCOUNTS

RYDES will be paid through pre-paid accounts.

ABOUT RYDE

RYDE is a pilot project offered through a collaboration between The Saratoga Area Senior Coordinating Council, West Valley Community Services, the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, Valley Transportation Authority, the cities of Saratoga, Cupertino, Monte Sereno, Campbell, and the town of Los Gatos.

WHAT IS RYDE?

RYDE is a curb-to-curb transportation and local trip planning service for adults 55+ living in the West Valley. RYDEs are delivered by a combination of paid and volunteer drivers.



HOW CAN I USE RYDE?

Schedule your RYDE for visits with friends, shopping, appointments as well as other locations within the five West Valley Cities. RYDE also provides trips to area doctors offices, hospitals and the Sunnyvale Transit Center.

WHO CAN USE RYDE?

Adults ages 55+ who reside in the cities of Campbell, Cupertino, Los Gatos, Monte Sereno, and Saratoga. Drivers will be able to assist with walkers and canes, but will not be able to accommodate wheelchairs, motorized scooters, or other similar mobility devices.



» HOW DOES RYDE WORK?

To book a RYDE, contact your local RYDE Coordinator. RYDEs can be scheduled between 36 hours and 5 weeks in advance.

» RYDEs are available to locations within the West Valley, including the Sunnyvale Transit Center, Kaiser Permanente, El Camino Hospital, and other select locations.

» RYDEs are not for emergency transportation. In the event of an emergency, please dial 911.

WHAT DOES RYDE COST?

RYDE fees are fixed based on the number of miles you travel to and from your destination.

» Up to 4 miles	\$ 9.00
» 4 miles to 8 miles	\$13.00
» 8 miles to 14 miles	\$18.00

ARE DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE?

Discounts of up to 90% off the standard RYDE fees are available for those who qualify. For information, contact your local RYDE Coordinator and ask for information about financial assistance.
