VTA ACCESS (PARATRANSIT)

VTA offers specialized accessible paratransit services to those with disabilities who are unable to independently use bus and light rail as specified in the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Service hours: Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Eligibility Requirements: Any person with a disability who is unable to board, ride, or disembark from an accessible vehicle without the assistance of another person (except for the operator of a lift or other boarding device). Any person with a disability who needs the assistance of a lift ramp to board, ride or disembark from an accessible vehicle an, accommodating vehicle is not available or key stations have not been made accessible.

EL CAMINO HOSPITAL ROADRUNNERS TRANSPORTATION

RoadRunners is a transportation service provided by dedicated El Camino Hospital Auxiliary volunteers. Transportation is provided for medical, dental, or any health related appointments.

Both the pick up location and the appointment location needs to be within a 10-mile radius of El Camino Hospital Mountain view or 8-mile radius of El Camino Hospital Los Gatos (excluding mountain geography). Riders do not need to be affiliated with El Camonio Hospital. Wheelchair transportation is not available.
