- Questioned the merchants' opportunity to make modifications or improvements to their back entrances.
- Commented on outreach and notification to the affected businesses prior to the start of the project.

**WEDGEWOOD STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS**

- Clarification regarding working with the water district and cost sharing for this project.
- Clarification regarding a new pedestrian strip along Wedgewood Avenue.

**ROBERTS ROAD BRIDGE**

- Clarification on the two year time frame for completion.
- Questioned addressing the traffic issues relating to the Festival of Lights until completion of the Roberts Road Bridge project.

**STREET REPAIR AND RESURFACING PROGRAM**

- Commented on finding the funding to maintaining the road system at the current pavement condition index of 75.
- Clarification regarding funding options to maintain the Town's road system.
- Questioned correlation of the PCI and maintenance costs.
- Clarification regarding funds and the priority of streets which need repair.
- Clarification regarding a plan and funding strategy for streets that are in serious despair.
