SUBJECT: ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM THE LOS GATOS POLICE FOUNDATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4200.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIX BALLISTIC VESTS TO BE USED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S RESERVE UNIT EMPLOYEES.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution authorizing the Town Manager to accept a donation from the Los Gatos Police Foundation in the amount of \$4200.00 for the purchase of six ballistic vests to be used by the Police Department's Reserve unit employees.

BACKGROUND:

The Los Gatos/Monte Sereno Police Department is committed to ensuring that all of its employees are afforded proper safety equipment to be used in the course of their duties. Over the past several years, the Los Gatos Police Foundation has received private donations and held several fund raising events with monies specifically designated for the purchase of supplies and equipment for the Los Gatos/Monte Sereno Police Department and its volunteer groups.

DISCUSSION:

The Los Gatos/Monte Sereno Police Reserve program has been in existence for over 30 years and currently is comprised of seven members, six of whom are assigned to the Operations Division. These employees supplement the department in a volunteer capacity. The warranties and suggested replacement dates on all their ballistic vests assigned to them are expired and further use of these ballistic safety vests is not recommended. Each vest needs to be replaced to comply with safety standards and manufacturer's warranties.
