COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Chair Rossmann discussed disseminating Commissioner Blum's CHSSC introduction letter to LGS Rec 55 Plus and LG/S Service Providers meeting. Chair Rossmann also discussed recent outreach efforts and communication with CASSY and El Camino. Commissioner Konrad commented that perhaps Hospice should be included in CHSSC health mandate. Commissioner Mathur inquired about the Commission's ability to have an Instagram account. Commissioners discussed Commissioner Konrad's inclusion in CHSSC goal assignments.

Trinh provided an update on LGS Recs vaccination engagement with the County. The County determined that the Rec Center doesn't provide sufficient space for vaccinations.

Liaison Andrews informed the Commission of the testing partnership with LGS Rec, County Public Health, and the Town. The next testing site will occur on February 19, 2021.
