

School Bus Pilot: Promotional Activities for School Year 2019/20 Service

Town staff is gearing up for the School Bus Pilot Service for the new school year working on promotional activities to increase ridership. With the continued assistance from the LGUSD, staff provided a new year service promotion message titled "Join Zippy on the School Bus" in the Back to School newsletter issue. In addition, promotional flyers have been posted around the Town. In the upcoming days leading up to the August 15 start date, staff will be updating the Town's School Bus website.

As of August 7, there are a total of 125 passengers that have signed up and purchased bus passes. The table below shows the details of the sign ups and provides a comparison to last year:
