The "IPM Fact Sheets" list steps for managing common pests **without** using harmful chemicals.

Many Fact Sheets also list "less-toxic products" which can be used for controlling the pest listed on that Fact Sheet.

These and similar less-toxic products are highlighted on the store shelves by "shelf talkers".

Products highlighted by these "shelf talker" labels are considered to be safer for use around your family & pets, and are safer for our environment, including our waterways.
