Dear Broadway Residents and Business Owners:

The Town of Los Gatos recently awarded a construction contract to Vanguard Construction to complete the concrete street reconstruction projects for Broadway and Bachman Avenue. The project includes the removal and replacement of the concrete streets, curbs, gutters, driveway approaches and some sidewalk. As discussed at the previous resident meeting, the project will also install a total of 66 new street trees on Broadway and Bachman Avenue and has identified the removal of 42 existing unsuitable street trees on these streets. The exhibits provided at the previous meeting showing these locations will also be available for review at the meeting. It is anticipated that construction will begin in mid/late May, following the Cat's Hill Bike Race.

Prior to construction, the Town and contractor would like to meet with the residents and business owners along each street to present the general construction process and schedule, and to discuss property/street access and other construction issues.

The meeting for the residents and businesses along Broadway will be held on **Monday, April 25, 2016** beginning at **6 p.m.** in the Council Chambers at the Town Hall, 110 E. Main St., Los Gatos, CA.
