

# Youth Commission Traffic Safety Ad-Hoc - Projects



## Pedestrian Safety Project

<i>Goals</i>	<p>Collect data on pedestrian safety around schools in Los Gatos, especially LGHS</p> <p>Provide recommendation to the Complete Streets and Transportation Commission (CSTC) and/or Town Council on how to make streets safer</p> <p>Promote eco-friendly commuting like walking and biking</p>
<i>Survey</i>	<p>Distributed a survey to every school in Los Gatos about use of different types of transportation and risk factors in walking and biking</p> <p>Survey collected almost 200 responses that will be used by the CSTC and other Town bodies to make decisions</p>
<i>Results Summary</i>	<p>Residents discussed concerns and suggestions for items like e-bike safety, bus routes, traffic enforcement, and safety at pedestrian crossings</p>

## E-Bike Safety

<i>Importance</i>	<p>Community members are increasingly reporting unsafe or illegal behaviors with e-bikes especially among kids, resulting in serious and avoidable accidents</p>
<i>Previous Years</i>	<p>In previous years, the Traffic Safety Ad-Hoc has created videos with the Police Department to educate kids on the importance acting safely with e-bikes</p>
<i>Actions</i>	<p>Traffic Safety created a flyer briefly outlining how and why to act responsibly with e-bikes</p> <p>Flyer was shared with schools around the community and on the town's social media account</p>
